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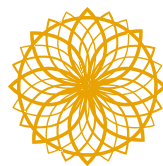

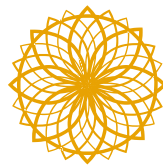
This is a book you will read and re-read many times, each time new beauties and higher truths unfolding themselves, causing you to value it as one of your dearest possessions.
